## WHAT TO KNOW

The Devils visited, and played, Philadelphia for the first time this season.

The Devils improved to 3-1-0 when scoring first in a game this season.

The Devils improved to 4-4-0 vs the Metropolitan Division in 2023-24.

The Devils surrendered 25 shots in the second period, which marked the most shots that the team allowed in a period this season (Prior: 10/29 vs MIN, 2<sup>nd</sup> per., 17 SOG, 4-3, W).

The Devils were outshot 47-35.

The Devils improved to 3-6-0 when outshot by an opponent this season.

The Devils opened their fifth back-to-back set for 2023-24, and improved to 4-1-0 in first games played. The team is now 5-3-1 overall for back-to-back sets for the season.

The team is now 2-0 for games decided in overtime in 2023-24.

## **PLAYER NOTES**

---

**Alexander Holtz** opened the scoring for the Devils 3:09 into the first period, after beating Philadelphia's Carter Hart glove-side with a wrister.

It marked Holtz' seventh goal of the season and second-career goal against Philadelphia, which were both earned in the City of Brotherly Love.

Per NHL Pr, "**Alexander Holtz** (49 GP) became the fourth Devils player in the past 10 years to score his 10th NHL goal before his 50th career game, joining **Jesper Bratt** (33 GP), **Yegor Sharangovich** (41 GP) and **Dawson Mercer** (47 GP)."

**Michael McLeod** earned the primary assist on Holtz' first-period goal and now owns three points in his last two games played (1g-2a). It marked McLeod's 11<sup>th</sup> career point against Philadelphia (4g-7a) in 17 games against the Flyers, which are his highest point totals against any NHL opponent.

**Colin Miller** earned his first point of the season and in a Devils sweater, after earning the secondary assist on Holtz' first-period goal.

**Jack Hughes** provided the Devils with a 2-0 lead 15:12 into the first period, also beating Hart with a wrister. The youngster earned his ninth multi-point game (1g-2a), which ranks first on New Jersey. Hughes finished with a three-point night (1g-2a), which marked his sixth three-point game this season.

Entering tonight's contest there were six players including Hughes who led the NHL who owned five games with three, or more, points.

**Dawson Mercer** earned the secondary assist on Hughes' first-period goal and extended his point-streak to three games (2-3a), which tied his season-high marker that was also earned from Nov. 10, 2023, to Nov. 16 (2g-1a).

**Tyler Toffoli** also extended his point streak to three games (3g-2a), after earning the primary assist on Hughes' first-period tally. It also tied a season-high marker for Toffoli, which he first earned from Oct. 20, 2023, to Oct. 25 (5g-1a).

Toffoli later earned the team's third goal, which was earned on power play 4:31 into the third period. It marked Toffoli's fifth multi-point game this season, which ranks third on New Jersey.

Nico Hischier earned the primary assist on Toffoli's power-play goal and extended his point-streak to three games (1g-3a). Hischier earned the secondary helper on **Luke Hughes'** overtime winner.

Luke Hughes earned his second career overtime goal and both over which were earned against divisional opponents (WSH).

Per NHL Pr, **Luke Hughes** became the first rookie in franchise history to score multiple overtime goals after netting his first on April 13.

Per NHL Pr, **Luke Hughes** became the seventh rookie defenseman in NHL history with multiple overtime goals. He joined **Shayne Gostisbehere** (4), **Moritz Seider** (2), **Cam Fowler** (2), **P.K. Subban** (2), **Jamie McBain** (2) and **Brent Seabrook** (2).

#### **QUICK HITS**

**Dougie Hamilton** was held out of the lineup (upper-body) and missed his first game of the season.

**Brendan Smith** was then moved back to defense after playing at the forward position for a majority of the team's last two games played.

**Luke Hughes** was hit on an icing call by Philadelphia's Garnet Hathaway and left the game late in the first period, while Hathaway was given a major penalty for boarding and a game misconduct. Hughes returned for the start of the second period.

**Samuel Laberge** inked his NHL debut and at the age of 26-years-old, after he was recalled from Utica (AHL) on Wed., Nov. 29 (4:00 TOI).

## **BETWEEN THE PIPES**

---

**Akira Schmid** earned the start against Philadelphia (3<sup>rd</sup> career start) and allowed a goal against Philadelphia for the first time since his first-career meeting against the Flyers back on Dec. 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2022 – 95:14 without allowing a goal against Philadelphia in parts of three games played.
