- The Devils are now 8-5-1 against the Atlantic Division for 2023-24.
- Jersey's team surrendered the game's first goal and fell to 13-15-1 when trailing first in a game this season.
- The Devils outshot Montreal 30-25, but fell to 16-7-2 when outshooting an opponent in a contest this season.
- New Jersey entered the third period trailing 2-0, and began the frame with 3:16 on a power-play (double minor, N. Suzuki, high-stick). The team then scored two power-play goals in 0:50 (L. Hughes & A. Holtz).

- Yet, the team fell short of entertaining its 15th comeback win for 2023-24. Entering the contest, the team's 14 comeback wins
 were tied with Dallas for the second most in the NHL (COL, 1st, 15 wins).
- The team snapped a five-game skid without recording a power-play goal, which also marked the eighth time this season that New Jersey recorded two PPG in a contest.

New Jersey is one of seven teams with 36, or more, power-play goals this season, while Colorado's 43 power-play goals rank first in the NHL, per Jan. 18.

New Jersey defensemen have combined for eight power-play goals this season, which ranks tied for first in the NHL with Edmonton, per Jan. 18.

The Devils have logged two, or more, power-play goals in a game 10 times this season, which ranked fourth in NHL, per Jan. 18. Tampa, Detroit and Carolina recorded 11 games with multiple power-play goals.

The Devils recorded four power-play goals in a game for the 17th time in franchise history, after the team's 5-4 overtime win vs NY Islanders on Oct. 20. The last time that the team scored four power-play goals in a game was March 1, 2014 at the New York Islanders in a 6-1 victory.

The most power-play goals that the franchise scored in a game was six, which was logged on Feb. 19, 1980, (CLR) vs Philadelphia in an 8-6 win at Colorado.

The most power-play goals earned in a game for Devils team history is five, which Jersey's team logged three times, last recorded: Jan. 22, 2008, at Philadelphia (7-3 win).

The Devils recorded two, or more, power-play goals in a game nine times this season, while Jersey's team earned two, or more, powerplay goals in a game four times last season.

LIGHTING THE LAMP/STREAK ENDED

The Devils streak without suffering a shutout of 101 consecutive games ended, after a 4-0 loss at Detroit on Wed., Nov. 22.

The streak dated back to Apr. 24, 2022, which was also a 3-0 loss to Detroit but at Prudential Center.

The 101 consecutive games without suffering a shutout over multiple seasons was the third-longest stretch in franchise history.

The team's longest stretch in franchise history over multiple seasons without experiencing a shutout against were 111 games played from Jan. 5, 1999, to Feb. 29, 2000.

The longest streaks in franchise history without suffering a shutout over multiple seasons:

New Jersey's 101 consecutive games without being shut out was the second-longest active streak currently in the NHL entering Wednesday, Nov. 22, contest at Detroit, while Toronto ranked first at 162 games.

The longest streak without experiencing a shutout all-time was Calgary – 264 consecutive games from Nov. 12, 1981, to Jan. 9, 1985.

IN THE DOTS

- New Jersey won 39 face-offs on Jan. 3, at Washington (39/68, 57%), which tied a season-high, prior: Nov. 7, 2023, at COL.
- Keep an eye on...Michael McLeod ranks first in the NHL for overall face-off% (66.0.%).
- He also ranked second for overall face-off% on the road (66.2%), and first overall face-off% at home (65.7%).
- McLeod owns the highest face-off percentage that a Devils skater logged this season (10 or more face-offs in a GP), which was 100.0%, after McLeod won 12/12 face-offs on Dec. 17, vs Anaheim.
- The effort marked the second time (since face-offs were tracked) in franchise history that a player won 100% of his face-off attempts while taking 12, or more, face-offs in a single game. The last time it happened was also Mcleod, which was logged on Jan. 22, 2023, vs Pittsburgh (13/13).
- McLeod earned a career-high 17 face-off wins on Sat., Dec. 30, at Boston (17/20, 85%).
- Nico Hischier won 17 face-offs (17/22) on Dec. 1, vs San Jose, which matched (M. McLeod) the most face-offs that a Devils skater won in a game this season.
- The Devils rank third in the NHL for overall face-off percentage (54.3%).
- Entering Friday's contest, the Devils ranked first in the NHL for defensive-zone face-offs at 59.2%.

COACH'S CORNER

Head Coach Lindy Ruff enters his fourth season with New Jersey, after he signed a multi-year contract extension on Wednesday, October 11th.

Ruff owns 856 career regular season wins, which ranks fourth all-time for all NHL head coaches. He passed Ken Hitchcock (849 wins) for sole possession of fourth place for all-time wins that an NHL head coach earned. Barry Trotz ranks third all-time for the most wins that an NHL head coach earned with 914.

Ruff earned his 100th career regular-season win with New Jersey, after Oct. 20th's 5-4 overtime victory at the NY Islanders. His 100 career wins with New Jersey tied him with Doug Carpenter (1985-1988) for the fourth most wins that a head coach earned with the franchise.

Ruff owns 120 career wins with New Jersey, which passed Peter Deboer for the third most wins that a head coach earned all-time for franchise history. (2nd, J. Hynes, 150 wins).

Ruff has coached 262 regular-season games with New Jersey, which passed Peter Deboer for the fourth most games coached all-time in franchise history.

LOOKING AHEAD

The Devils are scheduled to play in the 2024 Navy Federal Credit Union NHL Stadium Series game on Sat., Feb. 17, at MetLife Stadium vs the Philadelphia Flyers (8:00 P.M. E.T.). It marks the team's second Stadium Series contest (vs NYR, at Yankee Stadium, 7-3 loss).

New Jersey is also slated for 16 back-to-back sets this season, which are the most back-to-back games in the NHL for 2023-24. Washington and Minnesota rank second for this matter with 15 back-to-back sets during the 2023-24 campaign.

The organization is scheduled to honor three-time Stanley Cup champion **Sergei Brylin** on Sat., Jan. 20, as the club's second Ring of Honor inductee (Dr. John J. McMullen, the Devils' first owner who brought the team to New Jersey from Colorado was the 1st inductee).

COMEBACK KIDS

New Jersey led the NHL with 26 comeback wins last season, which set a new franchise record. The team passed the 2017-18 team's 23 comeback wins, which was the previous franchise record in a single season.

Per NHL Pr, the most comeback wins in a single season for NHL history is shared by the Panthers (29 in 2021-22) and Lightning (29 in 2018-19).

The team's 14 comeback wins in 2023-24 rank (tied, DAL & DET) second in the NHL, per Jan. 18. Colorado's 15 comeback wins ranked first in the NHL.

• Keep in mind that the most power-play goals that a Devils defenseman earned in a single season (team history) is five, which S. Niedermayer earned in 1992-93 and Eric Gelinas in 2013-14. L. Hughes' four power-play goals now rank third all-time for this matter in Devils team history. Bary Beck owns the franchise record with six power-play goals (CLR).

No. 13, The Captain

- Nico Hischier recorded his 11th career multi-goal game and his fourth power-play goal for the 2023-24 campaign, after Jan. 3rd, contest at Washington.
- The team's game played on Jan. 3rd, marked Hischier's second multi-goal game for 2023-24 (last: Dec. 9, 2023, at CGY, 2g-0a), and the captain's fifth multi-point game for the season.
- Hischier recorded first three-point effort for the 2023-24 campaign on Jan. 3rd, at Washington. It also nodded the captain's 12th career game with three, or more, points.
- The captain owns 309 career points (120g-189a), which passed Sergei Brylin for sole possession of 20th all-time in franchise history.

NO MERCY

- **Dawson Mercer** Dawson Mercer not only skated in his 200th career NHL contest via Jan. 3, and consecutive games played, but also became the 14th player in franchise history who scored a goal in his 200th career NHL game played...N. Bastian later became the 15th player in franchise history who earned his feat via Jan. 11, at TBL.
- Mercer collected his second goal of the game 7:16 into the third period on Wed., Jan. 3, at Washington, which provided the Devils with a 5-3 lead. The effort marked Mercer's first two-goal game for 2023-24 and fifth multi-point game for the season. As seen above, Mercer became the first player in franchise history who scored multiple goals in their 200th career NHL game played.
- The righthanded shot owns eight points (5g-3a) over the team's last 10 games played dating to Dec. 27, 2023.
 - Mercer's 5 goals lead New Jersey over that 10-game span.

BASS

Nathan Bastian played in his 200th career NHL game on Thu., Jan. 11, at Tampa, and became the 15th player in franchise history who scored in their 200th career NHL contest:

- Colin Miller not only netted his first goal in a Devils sweater on Jan. 6, vs Vancouver, but recorded his first-career multi-goal effort (2g-0a).
- Miller is also the lone Devils defenseman who earned a multi-goal game this season.
 - The last Devils blueliner who recorded a multi-goal game was **Dougie Hamilton** on Feb. 9, 2023, vs Seattle (2g-0a).
- Miller plus/minus rating at +11 leads all Devils skaters in 2023-24, while his career-high is a +23 rating with Dallas last season.
- The veteran blueliner logged a season-high 21:24 TOI in the team's outing on Jan. 11, at Tampa.

QUICK HITS

Alexander Holtz owns two goals over his last three games played, and earned his first power-play goal for 2023-24 on Wed., Jan. 17, vs Montreal.

Cal Foote logged his season debut on Wednesday vs Montreal (13:01 TOI).

Tyler Toffoli ranks third on New Jersey with 116 shots, while J. Hughes ranks first with 138 shots on goal. J. Bratt ranks second on the team with 124 shots.

Erik Haula recorded a career-high seven hits via Tue., Dec. 19, vs Philadelphia. His prior career-high for hits in a single game was four (12 times).

Kevini Bahl leads all Jersey blueliners with 77 hits, while Nathan Bastian (81) leads all Devils skaters this season.

Bahl recorded a career-high eight hits on Sat., Nov. 18, while his prior career-high was seven hits: May 8, 2021, at NY Islanders. The eight hits are the most that a Devils skater earned this season (B. Smith, 6, Nov. 10, vs WSH), and marks the most hits that a New Jersey skater earned in a game since N. Okhotiuk on Jan. 13, 2023, at Anaheim.

Bahl logged a career-high 23:37 TOI on Jan. 11, at Tampa, which led all Devils skaters in the contest.

Jonas Siegenthaler leads New Jersey with 58 blocks in 2023-24. John Marino ranks second with 50 blocked shots this season. The most blocked shots that a Devils skater earned in a single season was Andy Greene in 2018-19 with 208.

Marino also ranks first on New Jersey (active skaters) for ATOI (21:02).

TIMELESS...

Dawson Mercer has played in 206 consecutive games since he began his NHL career in 2021-22. Mercer owns the franchise record for the most consecutive games played to start an NHL career, after he passed Scott Gomez 140 consecutive games played from the start of an NHL career.

Mercer's 206 consecutive games played currently ranks 13th in the NHL for all active skaters.

Mercer's 206 consecutive games played ranks 10^{th} place all-time in franchise history, while Damon Severson's 208 consecutive games (4/7/18 – 5/10/21) rank ninth for franchise history.

Tyler Toffoli has played in 172 consecutive games, which ranks 19th for all active skaters in the NHL.

BETWEEN THE PIPES

Vitek Vanecek recorded 33 wins last season and become the second netminder in franchise history who earned 30, or more, wins in a single season. Prior to 2022-23, Martin Brodeur was the only netminder in franchise history who earned 30-or-more wins in a single season with the Devils, which he logged 14 times.

Vanecek owns 47 career wins with the Devils, which ranks ninth all-time for franchise history. Alain Chevrier ranks eighth all-time in franchise history with 53 career wins in a Devils sweater.

Vanecek is one of 11 NHL netminders with 14, or more, wins this season.

Nico Daws was recalled from Utica (AHL) on Dec. 27, while Akira Schmid was assigned to Utica (AHL) on Dec. 28.

Daws earned his first-career NHL point, after he was credited with the secondary assist on N. Hischier's first goal of the game on Jan. 3. Daws is the third different Devils netminder who earned a points/assist this season: **A. Schmid** (0g-2a) and **V. Vanecek** (0g-1a).

The 2023-24 campaign marks the fourth time in franchise history that three, or more, netminders recorded a point in a single season for the Devils:

1987-88: A. Chevrier, S. Burke, B. Suave

1982-83: G. Resch, R. Low, L. Middlebrook, S. MacKenzie

Daws recorded 36 saves in the winning effort on Saturday at Florida, while the netminder's career-high is 37 saves (logged twice, last: Jan. 6, 2024, vs VAN). The youngster also logged three consecutive starts, after playing in Boston on Monday and then against Montreal on Wednesday.
