## WHAT TO KNOW

The Devils and New York faced-off for the second of three matchups in 2024-25:

- **April 13 | Prudential Center | 1:00 P.M. E.T.**

The Devils are now 1-0-1 against the Islanders this season.

Tonight's victory marked the Devils' first overtime win for 2024-25 (1-2).

The win also extended New Jersey's winning streak to three games, which marks a season-high.

New Jersey erased a 3-1 deficit in the third period, after **Dawson Mercer** scored (3-2) with less than four minutes remaining in regulation and then **Stefan Noesen** tied the game with 0:50 second left in the game.

Jersey's team opened its fourth back-to-back set for 2024-25 and improved to 3-1-0 in first-half games of back-to-back sets. The team is now 4-2-1 overall for back-to-back sets this season.

The team hosts San Jose on Sunday night.

The Devils improved to 4-2-1 when trailing first in a game this season.

New Jersey improved to 2-2-0 when tied after two periods of play this season.

New Jersey was 24/54 on face-offs (44%).

The Devils outshot New York 33-22 and improved to 8-2-1 when outshooting an opponent this season.

The Devils have won five of their last six games (5-1-0).

## **PLAYER NOTES**

---

**Jack Hughes** tied the game at 1-1 on the power play and 5:57 into the first period, after beating New York's Ilya Sorokin with a snap shot from the left hashmark and glove side.

It marked goals in consecutive games for Hughes and the second time this season that the lefthanded shot earned goals in consecutive games (Oct. 27-Oct. 30).

The tally also marked J. Hughes' 297<sup>th</sup> career point.

Hughes later earned his 299<sup>th</sup> career point when he scored the overtime winner. The tally marked J. Hughes' seventh career overtime winner and second career OTG against the Isles (Oct. 20, 2023).

Hughes finished the night with three points (2g-1a), which marked consecutive games with three points.

**Dougie Hamilton** collected the primary assist on J. Hughes' power-play goal, which marked his ninth helper for the season.

Hamilton owns assists in three consecutive games, after tonight's effort. The blueliner's season-high point streak is four games, which was logged via Oct. 17 to Oct. 24 (1g-3a).

Hamilton's six power-play points (1g-5a) lead all Devils blueliners this season, which also ranks in the top 15 for all NHL defensemen in 2024-25.

Hamilton finished the night with three assists, which marked his most points in a game this season. The effort marked Hamilton's 18<sup>th</sup> career three point game.

**Jesper Bratt** logged the secondary assist on J. Hughes first-period goal, which marked Bratt's team-leading 14<sup>th</sup> assist for 2024-25. Bratt's 14 helpers rank in the top 10 for all NHL skaters this season.

The Swedish forward extended his point streak to three games (3g-3a). Bratt's season-high point-streak is six games via Oct. 19 to Oct. 30 (1g-6a). The helper marked Bratt's 19<sup>th</sup> career point (2g-17a) in 25 contests, while his 17 career assists against the Isles are tied for his most (BUF) against any opponent.

**Stefan Noesen** scored his seventh goal for the season and while the Devils utilized an extra attacker (2<sup>nd</sup> time this season scored with extra attacker). Noesen led the team with seven shots on goal, which marked a season-high (prior, 6 via Oct. 17, at OTT).
