WHAT TO KNOW

The Devils and Detroit faced-off for the second of three matchups in 2024-25:

o Apr. 16 | Prudential Center | 7:00 P.M. E.T.

The Devils are now 1-1-0 against Detroit this season.

New Jersey opened its fifth back-to-back set for 2024-25 and improved 4-1-0 in the first half of back-to-back sets. The team hosts Washington on Sat. Nov. 30, and is 5-3-1 overall for back-to-back sets this season.

The Devils improved to 8-5-1 when trailing first in a game this season.

New Jersey improved to 10-4-0 on the road this season, which is tied with Minnesota for the most road wins in the NHL.

New Jersey was 29/62 (47%) on face-offs.

The Devils outshot Detroit 29-28 and improved 12-5-1 when outshooting an opponent in a contest this season.

New Jersey recorded three power-play goals in a game for the third time this season, which leads the NHL.

PLAYER NOTES

Dougie Hamilton opened the scoring for New Jersey and on the power play 16:05 into the first period, which cut Detroit's lead down to 2-1.

The goal marked Hamilton's fourth tally of the season and third goal on the goal advantage in 2024-25. Hamilton now owns 28 career points (8g-20a) in 36 games against the Wings.

Hamilton earned his fourth multi-point game (1g-1a) this season.

Timo Meier earned a power-play goal 18:00 into the first period, which tied the game at 2-2. The tally marked Meier's second power-play goal for 2024-25.

The Swiss native later earned the primary assist on **Nico Hischier's** second-period goal and 11:10 into the frame. The assist marked Meier's 200th career assist and 399th career point. Meier's 200 career assists rank sixth all-time for all Swiss-born skaters.

The effort marked the forward's third multi-point game (1g-1a) for 2024-25.

Hischier also inked a multi-point effort (1g-1a), which marked the captain's seventh multi-point game for the 2024-25 campaign.

Stefan Noesen earned his 11th goal for the season and 16:49 into the second period, which lifted the Devils to a 4-3 lead.

Jack Hughes wasn't a stranger to the scoresheet, after the lefthanded shot earned one goal and one assist. Hughes also earned his third power-play goals, and game-winning goal, for 2024-25.

The effort marked Hughes' ninth multi-point game this season, which leads all Devils skaters in 2024-25

Quick Hits

Luke Hughes and Johnathan Kovacevic both earned one assist in the effort.

Kovacevic earned his ninth point and eighth assist for 2024-25, while the blueliner's career-high for points in a single season 15 (3g-12a, 2022-23 w/ MTL).

BETWEEN THE PIPES

Jacob Markstrom inked his 17th start for 2024-25. Markstrom displayed a number of key saves and also while the team was on the penalty kill.

The Swedish native earned his 11th win for the season, which are tied for the second most in the NHL with J. Oettinger and S. Bobrovsky.
