- The Devils opened their 2025-26 campaign on Sunday, September 21, after a 5-3 loss against the New York Rangers at Prudential Center.
 - The team then followed up its preseason opener with a 6-2 win against the New York Islanders on Tuesday, September 23, at Prudential Center.
- Jersey's team is scheduled to play seven preseason games, which includes a split-squad on September 28.
 - The Devils will host Washington on September 28, and then another squad travels to Quebec City to face-off against Ottawa.

- **Jake Allen** started in net for Jersey's team, while he recorded nine saves on 10 shots. The veteran netminder played 20:00 minutes, after playing in the first period.
- Nico Daws then replaced Allen and played in the second and third periods.
- Arseny Gritsyuk (1g-1a), Brian Halonen (1g-1a) and Dennis Cholowski (0g-2a) all recorded two
 points in the effort.
- Gritsyuk and Halonen both recorded power-play goals, while Cholowski's 22:59 TOI led all Devils skaters in the contest.
- Gritsyuk's six shots on goal led all skaters in the contest.
- Forward **Luke Glendening** (PTO) was 10/14 on face-offs (71.4%), which ranked first on New Jersey for skaters who logged more than five face-offs.
- Nathan Legare dropped the mitts twice, after logging two fighting majors against New York's Nathan Aspinall and Conor Mackey.
- **Kurtis MacDermid, Paul Cotter** and **Cody Glass** all wore alternate captain letters on their sweaters in the contest.
- New Jersey was 2/6 on the power play and 3/3 on the penalty-kill.
- The Devils also blocked 18 shots compared to New York's nine blocks.

Jersey's team logged 45 hits compared to New York's 19.

- Jacob Markstrom started the contest and played the full duration of the first period, while **Georgi Romanov** played in the full durations of the second and third periods.
- Jersey's team outshot the Isles 15-3 in the first period and finished the contest with 38 shots compared to New York's 15.
- New Jersey was three-for-four on the power-play.
- Simon Nemec led all Devils skaters with 22:31 TOI in the game.
- Captain **Nico Hischier** finished the contest with 11 face-off wins (11/18, 61.1%), while his 11 face-off wins ranked first for all skaters in the contest.
- **Connor Brown** earned the game-winner, after tallying the team's third goal 9:31 into the second period.
- On the blueline...**Dougie Hamilton** led all skaters from the contest with seven shots on goal, while **Ethan Edwards** also tallied his first NHL goal for the 2025-26 preseason.
