- The team improved its preseason record to 2-1-0, after its second victory against the Islanders this month.
- Jersey's team is 5/12 (41.7%) on the power play during the 2025-26 preseason, which ranked third in the NHL, per September 27.
- Jersey's team is scheduled to play seven preseason games, which includes a split-squad on Sunday,
 September 28.

- Arseny Gritsyuk earned the game-winning goal during the third period, which marked the Russian native's second goal for the 2025-26 preseason. Gritsyuk has played in all three of the team's preseason contests (2g-1a).
- Nathan Legare collected his second point (1g-1a) for preseason play, after netting the team's second goal in the contest against the Isles.
- Angus Crookshank chipped in an empty net goal 18:57 into the third period, which sealed New Jersey's 4-2 victory over the Isles.
- Goaltender Jake Allen logged 31:30 TOI and recorded 11 saves on 12 shots.
- Netminder **Jakub Malek** relieved Allen during the middle stages of the second period and earned the win, after logging 12 saves on 13 shots.
- New Jersey logged 15 blocked shots compared to New York's eight.
- Seamus Casey finished the night with two assists in his preseason debut.
- **Simon Nemec** led the team with 23:18 TOI.
